

Admission Requirements

Admission requirements are in accordance with admission policies of the university for all other B.S. programs at Wayne State University. In addition, students are required to achieve at least an overall 'B' (3.0) average in PHY 2130/31, PHY 2140/41 (or PHY 2170/71, 2180/81) and MAT2010 to be admitted to the Biomedical Physics program.

Graduation Requirements

Candidates for the BS in Biomedical Physics degree must complete at least 123 credits in course work including research and seminars. They must also satisfy the college group requirements and the university General Education requirement. All students are required to maintain an overall grade point average of C (2.0) in all degree work, as well as an overall grade point average of 2.5 in all major and cognate requirements.
